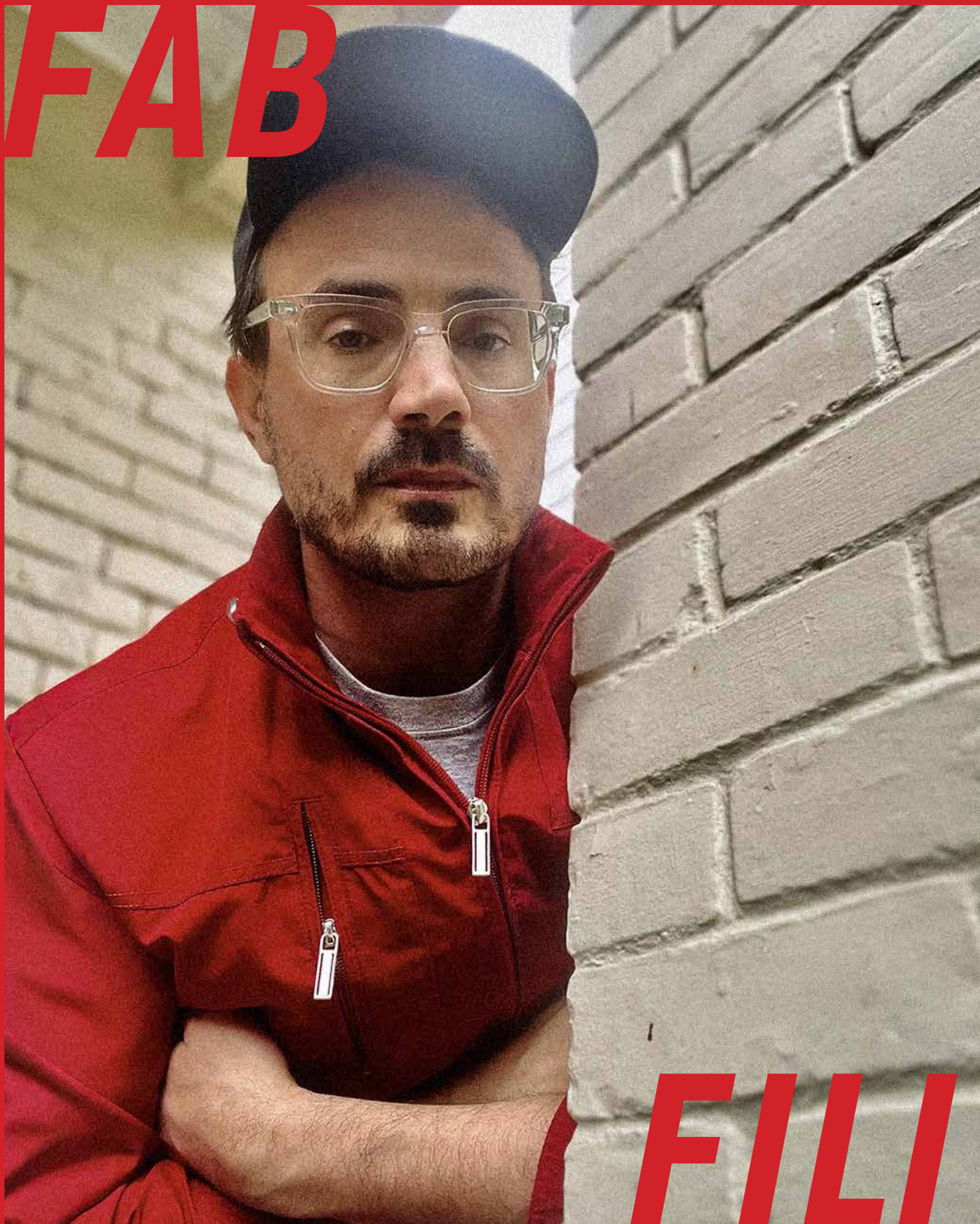

# KEYNOTE ADDRESS

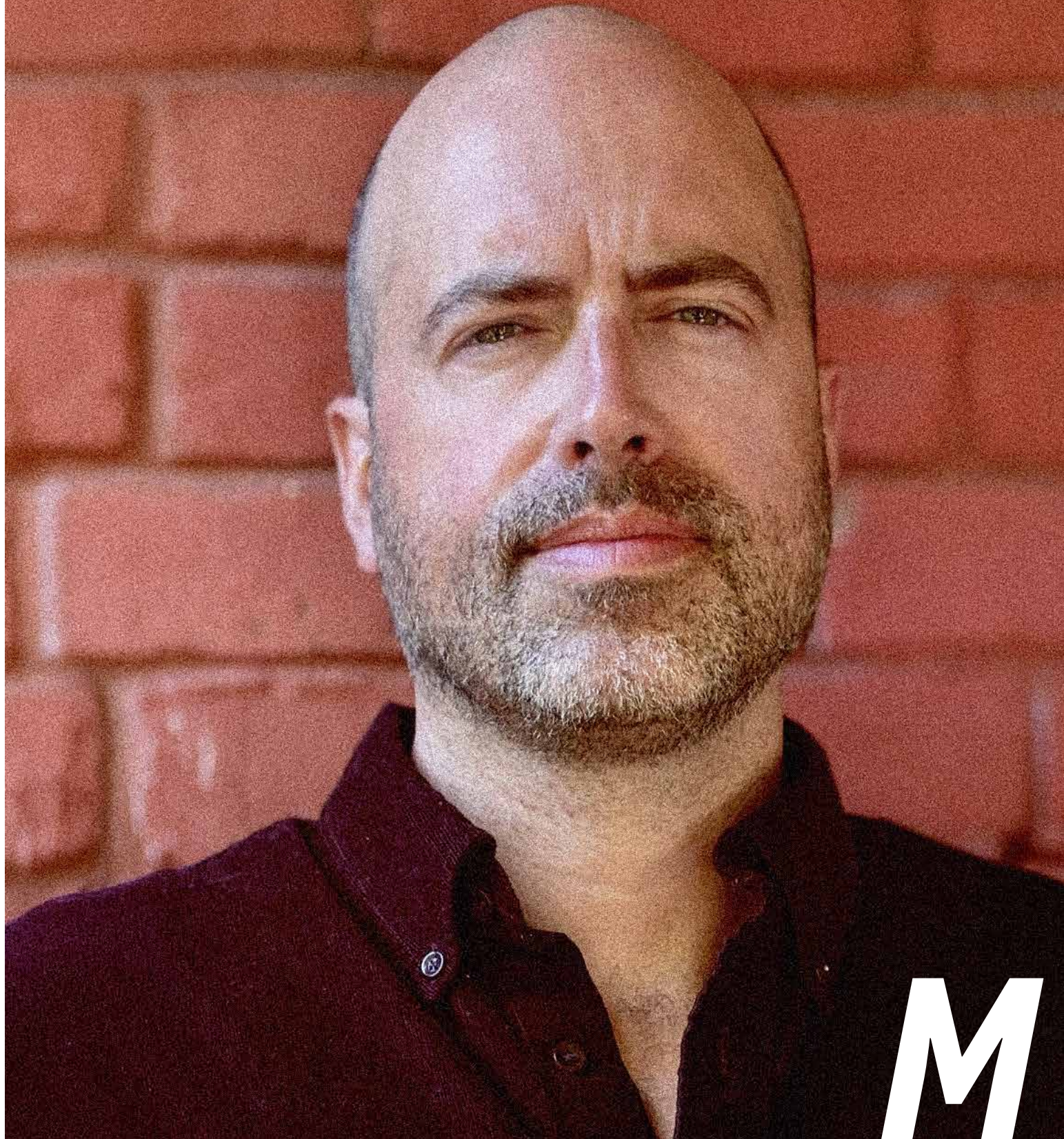
**FAB FILIPPO** is an award-winning producer-writer-director-showrunner. Most recently, he wrote, directed and was co-showrunner for *Sort Of*, a half-hour for CBC/HBOMAX (Sphere Prodc) – making top ten lists from Vanity Fair to Rolling Stone, as well as winning a Peabody Award.

He directed three episodes of *Small Achievable Goals* for CBC and is currently developing an hour-long with Killer Films and FX, as well as a new comedy with Pageboy (Elliot Page's company). Before that, he wrote, directed, and acted as showrunner for the critically acclaimed and award-winning shortform series *Save Me*, which was nominated for over 20 international festival awards and a Webby, and the hit series *Billable Hours* with co-creator Adam Till.

As an actor, you might know him from such projects as *Lives Of The Saints* starring opposite Sophia Loren, indie hit *waydowntown*, or as Ethan Gold in the groundbreaking Showtime series *Queer As Folk*. He is often recognized for an acting stint on the hit *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*.

# KEYNOTE ADDRESS

**KYLE MUIR** is a screenwriter and narrative designer with credits across television and AAA video games. His TV work includes *Billable Hours*, *Detentionaire*, *Call Me Fitz*, and *Mother Up!*, where he built a reputation for sharp dialogue, versatile storytelling, and pretending this was all part of the plan.

In games, Kyle has written for major franchises such as *Far Cry 5*, *Far Cry 6* and *Starlink: Battle for Atlas*. His focus is on character, world-building, and player choice in large-scale interactive narratives – basically making sure players have fun while blowing stuff up.

He has also developed and sold original projects to FOX, Sacha Baron Cohen, CBC, and Just for Laughs – proof that he can pitch to just about anyone, including Borat.

Alongside his writing, Kyle teaches and mentors emerging talent, sharing the lessons of a career spent bridging screen and game storytelling. He remains convinced this is a real job.

**ANDRÉS SEVILLA** is an award-winning designer, educator, and entrepreneur bridging professional practice and higher education. Originally from Monterrey, Mexico, he holds a bachelor's degree in Industrial Design and a master's degree in Product Innovation from programs in Mexico and Sweden.

Since 2013, Andrés has taught industrial and graphic design, business, and entrepreneurship, reaching senior faculty roles in Mexico before joining Toronto Film School in 2020. At TFS, he leads courses in Digital Imaging, Web Design, and Art Direction, blending studio-based learning, visual storytelling, and critique to prepare students for professional design environments. His teaching emphasizes creativity, inclusivity, and confidence, guiding students to bring their identities and perspectives into their work.

Alongside academia, Andrés leads Vanuva, his design consultancy founded in 2015, and contributed to high-profile projects like the City of Monterrey's official visual identity. Since moving to Canada, he has expanded his expertise in Education through a Graduate Certificate at Yorkville University and programs offered by the Centre for Teaching Excellence and Innovation. He actively integrates emerging technologies into his practice and channels his skills into projects that connect real-world design with the classroom.

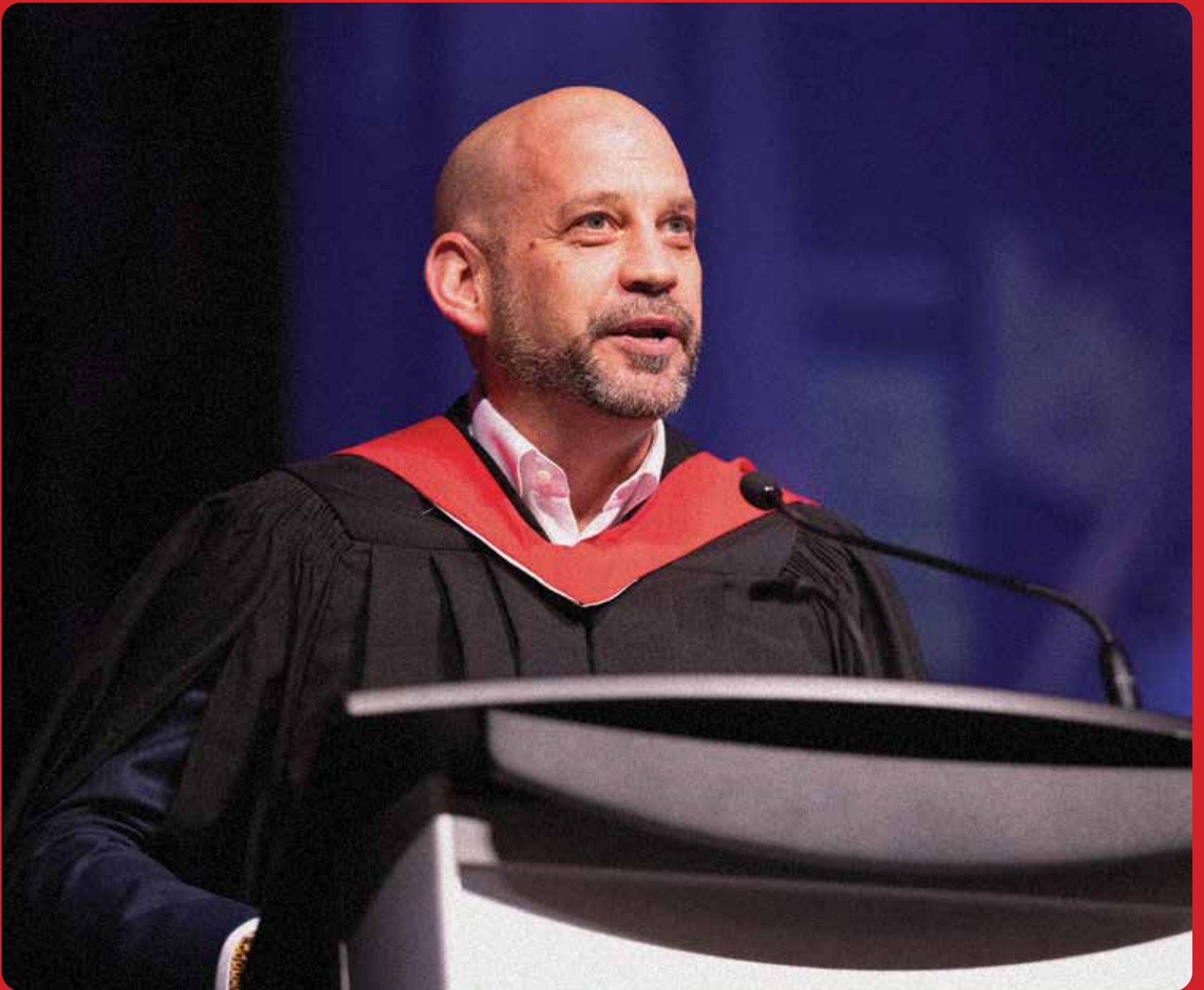

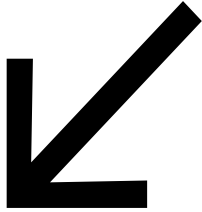

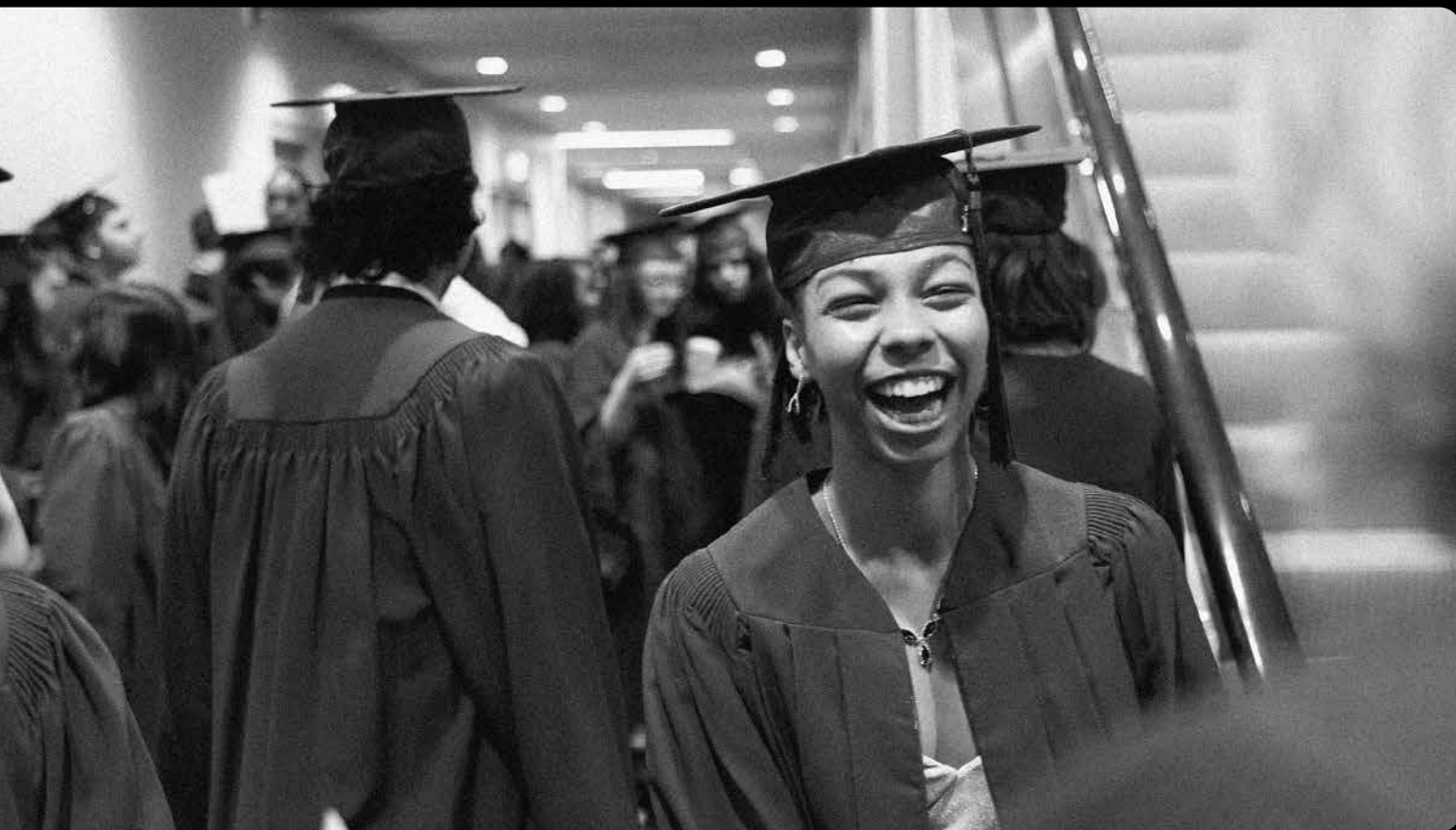
## SOPHIA CANO

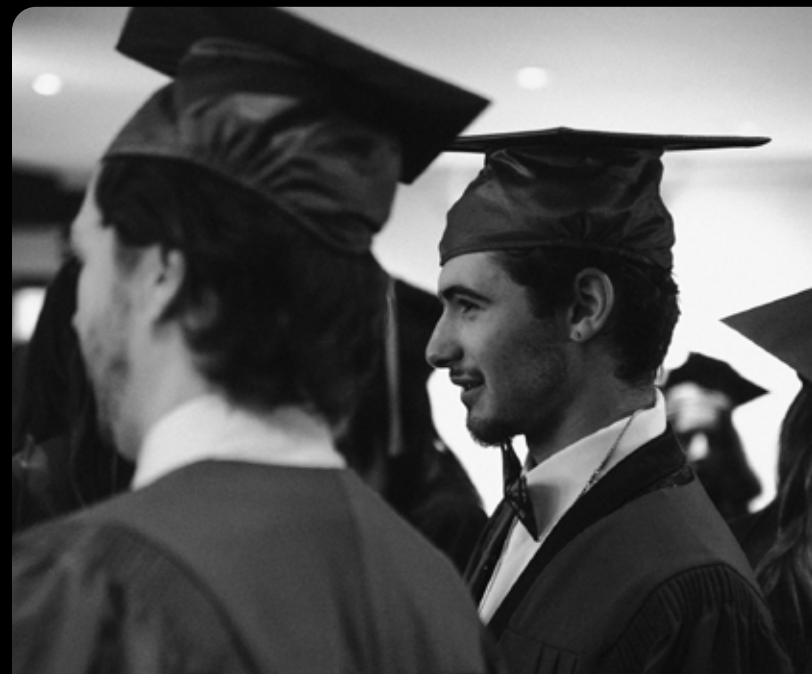

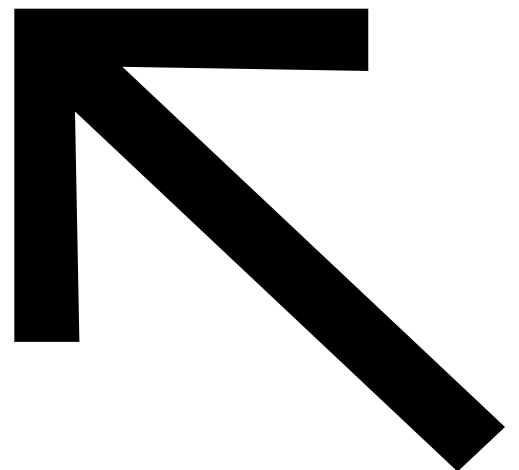
